

經濟社會學專題：全球化與東亞資本主義

有關東亞經濟發展的研究已經很多，本課程經不再重複閱讀與討論太多相關的文獻，而將集中在 1990 年代全球化影響之後的東亞，而討論的重點將集中在南韓、台灣與中國，議題也將以政治經濟發展、金融體制與科技學習上。

過去對東亞的研究，主要論點認為發展型國家在期中扮演重要角色，而在全球化的轉型階段，則有人認為國家能力將消滅，也有人認為將持續，我們將檢視其中的辯論，也可透過金融和科技體制的發展看到癥結所在。另外，中國的崛起對過去東亞的研究而言，將是一個新的領域，是發展型國家嗎？或是地方政府為主？對區域經濟造成何種影響，而中國的發展從改革以來發生何種變化，這些都是重要議題，我們也將討論。
