Marriage and the Family

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課程簡介

家庭，作為提供社會化 (socialisation) 的第一個場域，以及組成家庭的主要元素－婚姻，是社會學分科裡重要且與每個人切身相關的。但對家庭的研究並不只是社會學的專屬主題，家庭所包括的層面廣泛，包含夫妻關係、親子關係、性行為、經濟功能、子女教育等等，不能只以社會學觀念和理論來解釋。

這門課除了討論家庭社會學的重要理論之外，也會帶領學生閱讀近期相關學術研究期刊論文，藉此比較台灣社會的婚姻與家庭及西方家庭的組成變革有何不同。透過實證研究的發現，來了解婚姻與家庭的維持與瓦解、家務與經濟活動之分工、性別態度、兩性對性關係看法的差異、婚姻品質的決定因素等議題。

課程評量

本課程評量主要依據報告、考試成績及參與表現：

- (1) 指定閱讀導讀 (30%)：小組導讀指定閱讀書籍篇章或學術期刊論文。請自行分組，以3至4人為一組，導讀時間約30分鐘，每組導讀兩次，並請提供書面導讀大綱。
- (2) 課堂參與 (10%)：包含課堂出席狀況及參與討論的程度。
- (3) 期中考試 (25%)
- (4) 學期報告 (35%)：請於期末考前一週上課時繳交（字數上限為5000字）。請選擇有興趣的家庭相關議題或特定家庭現象進行研究，內容必須包括議題或現象的基本描述，並運用課程上討論的觀點、概念、理論進行分析與解釋。
